DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 July 2022 Arrival – Nairobi

On arrival at JKIA, our customer service representative will meet you and transfer you to Nairobi Serena Hotel; enjoy dinner at the Café Maghreb and settle in for the night.

Overnight at Nairobi Serena Hotel (Standard Room) – DELUXE ROOM HALF BOARD BASIS

Day 2: Nairobi (with Excursions)

Breakfast at the hotel. Your driver will pick you up at 1130hrs, you will drive to Talisman Restaurant for lunch. After Lunch, visit Giraffe Centre, thereafter visit Daphne Sheldrick's Elephant Orphanage for the Foster Parent Visit at 1630hrs. Please Note that Guests are required to have done the online adoption process in advance prior to visiting. The Adoption Fees is also done online, currently US\$ 50.00 Per Couple or Per Person (Fees are paid directly and are not included). Please carry your digital Foster Certificate on the day you are visiting.

Overnight at Nairobi Serena Hotel (Standard Room) – DELUXE ROOM HALF BOARD BASIS

**Day 3****Nairobi – Amboseli National Park**

After breakfast at the hotel, you will be transferred to Wilson Airport for your flight to Amboseli departing at 0730hrs to arrive at 0855hrs. Please note that might route via different destinations depending on the day's load.

Upon arrival, you will be met at the Airstrip by your driver guide. A game drive enroute to the lodge.

Amboseli National Park is located at the foot of Africa's highest mountain, Mount Kilimanjaro. The snow-capped peak of Mount Kilimanjaro rises above a saucer of clouds and dominates every aspect of Amboseli. This park covers only 150 square miles but despite its small size and its fragile ecosystem it supports a wide range of mammals and birdlife.

Amboseli is popular with birders as Elephant watchers. Over 400 species including at least 40 raptors have been recorded. Notable species include the Lesser Flamingo, many ducks, darters and heron nest in the wetlands, and birds of prey including a small population of Martial Eagles.

Lunch will be at your lodge followed by an afternoon game viewing drive. Later as the sun sets, you will be transferred back to your lodge for dinner and overnight

Overnight at Amboseli Serena Lodge – Standard Room Full board

Day 4:**Amboseli National Park**

This morning, enjoy a game drive. On a clear morning you could see a spectacular view of Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest mountain in Africa at some 19,341 feet. The park affords you the best opportunity to get close to the mighty elephant.

You might also spot Cape buffalo, zebra, wild dog, and others. During the heat of the day, relax at your lodge. You will have a game viewing drive in the afternoon. All meals and overnight at the lodge

Overnight at Amboseli Serena Lodge – Standard Room Full board

Day 5**Amboseli – Nairobi – Mara Game Reserve**

After breakfast, check out and transfer to the Airstrip for a morning flight to Wilson Airport departing at 0830hrs to arrive at 0930hrs. Connect onto your scheduled flight to Masai Mara departing at 1000hrs to arrive at 1100hrs.

Upon arrival in Masai Mara, you will be met by your driver guides and transfer to the lodge for check-in and lunch.

In the afternoon, proceed for game drive in the reserve. After the game drive you will return to the camp dinner.

Overnight at Sarova Mara Game Camp – Club Tent Full Board



Day 6 & 7: Masai Mara Game Reserve

Early morning and afternoon game drives. Alternatively, you can choose to have a full day game drive with packed lunch.

Masai Mara is a magnificent landscape of open plains bisected by the Mara River and its tributaries, and punctuated by marshes and forests. The most frequented game reserve in Kenya, this 250 square-mile reserve supports the highest density of game to be seen anywhere. During the seasonal migrations, Masai Mara is home to up to a million wildebeest and an equally impressive number of zebras that move into the area from neighboring Serengeti National Park, in Tanzania. The reserve is home to all the “big five” and it is also possible to observe baboon, eland, ostrich, bat-eared fox, jackal and cheetah. The rivers abound with hippos and crocodiles.

Optional Activity: For an additional cost you can take Balloon Safari or visit to a Masai Village All meals and overnight stay at the camp

Overnight at Sarova Mara Game Camp – Club Tent Full Board

Day 8 : Masai Mara Game Reserve

Early morning return to the Lodge for Breakfast after which you will check out and drive to Kichwa Tembo Camp with an enroute midmorning game drive. Check in on arrival for Lunch followed by an afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at the Camp

Overnight at Kichwa Tembo Tented Camp – Superior View Full Board

Day 9 & 10: Masai Mara Game Reserve

Day spent in Masai Mara enjoying morning and afternoon game drives all Meals and overnight at All meals and overnight stay at the Lodge

Overnight at Kichwa Tembo Tented Camp – Superior View Full Board

Day 11 Masai Mara – Nairobi - Depart

Breakfast at the camp. Check-out and transfer to the airstrip for your morning flight to Nairobi departing at 1100hrs. Arrive at 1220hrs and transfer to the Carnivore restaurant for lunch. Thereafter transfer to Ole Sereni Hotel where you have a dayroom booked. Check out at 1800hrs and later you will be transferred to the airport for your flight home.

Reservations, Deposits, and Payment: (Due to Covid-19 we highly recommend Travel Insurance)

- A non-refundable deposit of \$3000 per person is required at the time of booking.
- Final payments for land arrangements are due 90 days from the departure date.
- Some promotional packages will require full payment at the time of reservations.
- Payment may be made by check or via PayPal. Payment is payable to Simba Marara Expedition, Inc.
- Bookings made within 60 days prior of departure require full payment at the time of reservation and are non-refundable.

Cancellation and No show charges.

Cancellations must be made in writing to Simba Marara Expedition, Inc.

Reservations that are cancelled, reduced in length of stay or reduced in numbers (hereinafter collectively called a CANCELLATION) are subject to the following Cancellation and No Show fees:

- 90 days prior to arrival: 100%
- No Show: 100%
- There is no refund for any unused portions of the tour program once tour has commenced.

Baggage Information

- Baggage allowance for domestic flights is 15kgs (33 pounds) per person, including hand luggage.
- Soft-sided luggage or duffels are preferable to hard luggage for storage on safari vehicles in Africa. Large suitcases of dimensions greater than 24"x 17"x 7" are impossible to store in vehicles and on aircraft and should not be used. (Baggage and personal effects are at owner's risk throughout the tour and baggage insurance for clients is strongly advised).

Cancellation/Travel/Medical Repatriation Insurance

- Travel insurance is strongly recommended to protect your investment in case of cancellation due to family, work related or medical conditions.
- Medical repatriation insurance is required.
